ONE WINDOW WAS ON THE EAST AND THE THREE WINDOWS AND DOOR WERE ON THE SOUTH. THERE WERE BLOCKS TO STEP ON IN FRONT OF THE DOOR AND THE HOUSE WAS ON A FOUNDATION OF ROCKS.(BBB)

SOMETIME AFTER MOVING INTO THE HOUSE IN 1936 THEY BEGAN THE PROJECT OF CHANGING THE HOUSE. THE FLOORS WERE RAISED 1 1/2 FEET INSTEAD OF LOWERING THE CEILINGS. AIR DUCTS AND ELECTRICITY WERE PUT IN. TWO DORMERS WITH WINDOWS AND NEW WINDOWS FOR OLD WERE PUT IN UPSTAIRS. THE WINDOWS AND DOOR DOWNSTAIRS WERE REMOVED.
