INEZ WAS THE OLDEST. SHE WAS THE MOST AGGRESSIVE ONE OF THE FAMILY. SHE WAS VERY BOSSY, BEING THE FIRST BORN. SHE WAS ONE OF THE BEST HEARTED PEOPLE. SHE WOULD DO ANYTHING FOR ANYONE AND WOULD GIVE YOU THE DRESS OFF HER BACK.(H59)

INEZ WAS ABITIOUS AND A HARD WORKER. SHE DID HOUSE-WORK FOR A NUMBER OF PEOPLE. AS KIDS, WE SWEEPED AND DUSTED TWO ROOMS IN THE SCHOOL HOUSE FOR 15 CENTS A NIGHT. WE HAD VERY LITTLE MONEY, SO 75 CENTS LOOKED LIKE A FORTUNE TO US.(H59)
