HE WAS BEING CARRIED ON HIS BACK, THE NEIGHBOR SLIPPED AND FELL, PARLEY GOT HURT AND DIED. CHARLES THOMAS COULDN'T GET ALONG WITH THE OTHER KIDS SO HE WENT TO LIVE WITH A DR. GEORGE SMITH IN MONTPELIER ID. (NNN)

IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE FAMILY SOLD THIS PLACE AND LIVED WHERE THEY COULD. THERE WAS A KING FAMILY THAT LIVED SOUTH OF H-3 AND IN H-6. WILFORD KING WAS THE OLDEST ONE AT HOME. THEY TOOK CARE OF THEMSELVES WITH THE HELP OF THEIR NEIGHBORS. (NNN)
