NEPHI AND ADA HOMESTEADED 160 ACRES EAST SIDE OF BEAR LAKE ID  
 NEAR PEGRAM ID AT ANTELOPE OR POVERTY FLATS. THEY LIVED IN A  
 SINGLE ROOM AND ALL THE WATER HAD TO BE HAULED FROM 3 TO 4 MILES  
 AWAY. THEY WOULD CROSS THE FROZEN LAKE IN THE WINTERTIME TO  
 TRAVEL TO GEORGETOWN ID. (B10)

IN 1917 THEY BOUGHT ABEL AND EMMA IRENE SMART'S HOUSE (M-16) AND  
 160 ACRES OF LAND AND MOVED THEIR FAMILY THERE. IN 1929 THEY  
 BOUGHT THIS PLACE (A-8) FROM JOSEPH HEPWORTH BEE. IT HAD A LARGE  
 KITCHEN, LIVING ROOM, TWO BEDROOMS AND EVENTUALLY A BATHROOM.  
 THEY ADDED AN L-SHAPED SCREENED PORCH WHICH SERVED AS AN ENTRANCE  
 INTO THE KITCHEN AND A STORAGE AREA. IT WAS BUILT OVER A SMALL  
 CELLAR AND THE STORAGE SPACE UNDER THE HOUSE WAS USED FOR STOR-  
 AGE. A WATER TANK LOCATED IN THE ATTIC WAS FED WITH SPRING WATER  
 FROM THE CELLAR THAT WAS PUMPED BY WATER POWER FROM THE CREEK.  
 IT PROVIDED A GRAVITY FLOW OF RUNNING WATER INTO THE HOUSE AND IT  
 WAS AN INNOVATIVE INVENTION OF JOSEPH BEE. (B10)

WHEN THEY BOUGHT THIS FARM IT HAD A GRAIN ROLLER. IT RAN OFF  
 WATER POWER. IT WAS ONE THAT JOSEPH HEPWORTH BEE HAD USED TO  
 ROLL GRAIN FOR EVERYONE IN TOWN. (AAA)

NEPHI WAS JUST A REALLY GOOD HAPPY KIND OF PERSON. (AAA) NEPHI  
 WAS A BIG MAN. (H15) NEPHI WORKED FOR ABEL SMART AT THE GEORGE-  
 TOWN ID POWER PLANT. (B10) FRANCES WRIGHT MUNK WOULD QUOTE NEPHI  
 PAYNE AS SAYING "YES SIR! THE PREDICAMENTS IS COMIN' TRUE." (DD)

ADA WAS A TALL, RAW-BONED, MUSCULAR LOOKING WOMAN. (DD) ADA WAS A  
 REAL GOOD HAPPY KIND OF PERSON. (AAA) ADA WAS A QUILTER. (Q)  
 ADA HAD GRAY EYES AND NATURALLY CURLY HAIR LIKE HER MOTHERS' (EMMA  
 IRENE STALEY SMART (M-8)). ADA HAD A WARM CHEERFUL DISPOSITION.  
 SHE WAS AN EXCELLENT SPELLER, MATHMETITIAN, HAD BEAUTIFUL PENMAN-  
 SHIP BUT ONLY WENT TO THE 4TH GRADE. SHE LEARNED TO PLAY THE  
 PIANO BY EAR. (B10)
