IN THE FALL OF 1900 WE LIVED  
 IN THE FRONT PART OF C-4 FOR  
 A YEAR. WE BOUGHT THIS LAND  
 AT A-4 FROM GEORGE T. SMITH IN  
 1902. I HAULED LOGS FROM THE  
 CANYON ASSISTED BY MY BROTHER,  
 FRANKLIN ROSA BACON, AND WE GOT  
 OUR NEIGHBORS TO HELP AND SOON HAD A HOUSE RAISED TO THE SQUARE.  
 GEORGE T. SMITH DID THE CAR-PENTRY WORK. CHARLOTTE (LOTTIE) SMIT  
 BACON BOUGHT ENOUGH BEEF TO FEED THE WHOLE TOWN FOR \$1.34. IT  
 WAS A TWO-ROOM LOG HOUSE WITH A SECOND STORY. THE WINDOWS WERE  
 TALL AND NARROW. ALBERT BUILT A FRAME KITCHEN ON THE BACK AND A  
 NICE WIDE STAIRWAY LEAD-  
 ING UPSTAIRS. (H11)
