OUR HOUSE HAD A LAWN ALL AROUND IT. OUR FRONT FENCE WAS WIRE NET WITH A TWO-BY-FOUR PIECE OF LUMBER ON THE TOP OF IT.(H18)

WE HAD BIG SHADE TREES ALL ALONG THE FRONT OF THE PLACE. ELDRED RUSSELL BACON, MY BROTHER, SAID THEY WERE 'BALM OF GILLIAD'. WE EACH HAD A TREE AND WE WOULD CLIMB UP IN THE TREE. THEY WENT ALL THE WAY DOWN THE LANE TO A-2.(H18)

THERE WAS A BIG CEMENT CELLAR OUT BACK AND A DEEP WELL CASED WITH ROUND CEMENT RINGS PLACED ONE ON TOP OF ANOTHER. THE WATER WAS DRAWN UP IN BUCKETS.(H18)

THERE WAS A BIG BARN AND A LARGE SHED OUT BACK. IT HAD BIG BOARDS ABOUT A FOOT OR SO WIDE. IT WAS TWO STORIES HIGH BECAUSE THEY PUT THE THRASHING MACHINE IN THERE. IT HAD A LOFT AT ONE END AND THAT WAS WHERE THE HIRED MAN SOMETIMES HAD HIS BED UP THERE.(H18)

WE HAD A BIG FOLDING BED IN THE FRONT ROOM. IT HAD A BIG MIRROR ON IT WHEN IT WAS PUT UP. IT WAS LIKE A BIG WARDROBE OR CHIFFONIER.(H18)

HE WOULD LIGHT THEM AND SIT THERE AND WATCH WHILE WE PERFORMED AROUND. THEY WERE REAL CANDLES. THERE WAS HARD CANDY OF RED AND GREEN AND BLUE. THERE WAS ANIMALS TOO THAT WERE USED FOR DECORATIONS. WE ATE THEM EVENTUALLY WE MADE POPCORN BALLS AND STRUNG POPCORN.(H18)
