THE MUTUAL IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION OF THE GEORGETOWN ID WARD WAS BEGUN ON 1 JANUARY 1894. JOSEPH CLARK WAS THE PRESIDENT OF THE YOUNG MEN AND MARY JANE BEE WAS THE PRESIDENT OF THE YOUNG WOMEN.

ON 1ST MAY 1915 THE FIRST BEEHIVE WORK WAS ORGANIZED. ENEZ T. HOFF WAS THE BEE-KEEPER AND ALICE R. CLARK THE ASSISTANT. THE SWARM WAS DIVIDED BECAUSE OF ALL THE GIRLS THAT WERE IN THE SWARM. CHARLOTTE SMIT BACON WAS THE ASSISTANT TO ENEZ HOFF.
