The little apt will cost us \$12.00 per month or \$6.00 a piece and everything is furnished such as coal, gas, lights, Bed clothes & linen, towels, and dishes. The Lady, a Mrs Johnson, also does the washing of towels & bed linen free. Pretty good eh!

I am going to have to either get you to send my basket ball gym suit or get a new one up here. You see I am to take charge of some morrow boys who are playing around town.

Well, Darling I'm so busy right now that I'll have to stop this letter now but will write another soon.

Write soon and tell me all the news. I'll be waiting to hear from you.
